When is the competition?

October 29 - November 2, 2012

Who can register?

Registrants must be a registered student of a college or university.

- 1. You can register as a team* to participate as one of the disputing parties in a mediation
- 2. You can register as an individual mediator to mediate a dispute.

*Disputant teams are limited to no more than 3 members.

What types of cases will be used?

Disputes included in the competition may include workplace or small claims community disputes.

What will the online competition be like?

All communication within Modria is currently asynchronous. Next year, Modria's platform will be expanded to include both real-time chat and video elements. For this year's competition each round will be approximately 2.5 days.

How many rounds of competition will there be?

The competition will consist of no less than two rounds. Depending on the total number of participants, additional rounds may be added.

How will the competition be evaluated?

All communications will be judged on a scale of 1-5 by professionals within the field of ADR. The scores for each team in each round will be added together for a final score. A winning team and a winning mediator will be announced based on the highest tallied scores.
